Lynn is twenty-one and living with a friend. She is working part-time and hoping it will be full time soon. I inform her that the pregnancy test is positive and she states, "I know." Lynn had already taken a home pregnancy test and was not happy about the pregnancy. She said when the father of the baby was told about the possible pregnancy, he said that he was not supporting a baby and with that, he was "gone." After further conversation about what her plans were for the pregnancy, the Lord opened the door for a spiritual discussion. Lynn started crying and said, "Life has to change; everything is a mess." As I shared about God's love through the Scriptures, this young woman made a decision of faith. Praise God! With more discussion and prayer, Lynn decided to place her child for adoption. She called and made an appointment to meet with a Christian Adop-



tion Agency.

A follow up phone call was made to Lynn one week later and she sounded upbeat. She stated her employer had offered her a full-time job with benefits. We closed our conversation with prayer, thanking God for the fulltime job and for His protection over her. We prayed that she would find a home church soon.

Women and families who come through our doors are dependent on us to help them in their time of need. It takes team effort with God's guidance to make a difference in each person with whom we are blessed to serve. Thank you for your vital part in this ministry!
